Fall Lawn Care Tips for Florida Residents

Mow: Continue mowing regulary, but lower the blade height slightly as the grass slows down. A lower height helps the grass dry faster and prevents fungal diseases.

Water: Reduce watering gradually, moving from a summer schedule to 1-2 times per week by mid-fall. Avoid overwatering to prevent disease and promote healthy roots.

Fertilize: Avoid fertilizing after September. If you do fertilize, use a fertilizer high in potassium. Fertilizing too late can cause your grass to grow through the winter and become more sensitive to the cold.

Aerate: Aerate your lawn to improve oxygen flow, relieve soil compaction, and promote stronger root growth. Aeration is especially important during the cooler months.

Overseed: Overseed thin or patchy areas with a compatible grass variety to thicken your lawn and improve its health.

1.ONLY VISIT HOMES THAT HAVE A PORCH LIGHT ON.
